

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

MARKET MAKERS is an entrepreneur-based financial literacy program for students in underserved schools and communities. It provides students with an opportunity to experience first-hand how financial literacy can benefit their lives, families and communities.

Students in the semester-long program meet with volunteers from the business community, either at school or on field trips to the volunteer's workplace. The program culminates in a citywide marketplace, where students from all participating schools come together on a Saturday to sell their goods to each other and the broader community.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS AND DETAILS

The monthly commitment includes five (5) visits with student participants as follows:

- **Visit #1** - at the school
- **Visit #2** - at the volunteer's place of employment or at the ExpandedED Schools office (if volunteer's workplace is not conducive to field trips). This can expand to a career day, which could include several other people from the volunteer's place of employment discussing their role in the company. If neither a school or office visit is possible, a Skype visit may be permissible.
- **Visit #3** - at the school or via Skype to prepare for the marketplace
- **Visit #4** - at the citywide marketplace
- **Visit #5** - final student presentation at the school or via Skype (in person is preferred) with school leaders, volunteer coach and business sponsors.

While both volunteers should make the first visit to the school together, the remaining visits can be split. Volunteers must sign a commitment contract with the dates that they will visit, host and/or participate via Skype.
