Policy Updates

- New York City committed \$4 million to "Tutoring support for kindergarten through second grade literacy and sixth through eighth grade math education at select schools across the city"
 - Submitted testimony to City Council Committee on Education advocating for city funding
- Submitted letters of support advocating for state funding for a HIT pilot program
